Q1: Who will sanction the Resolution Plan?

The Resolution plan will be approved by the Committee of Creditors (CoC) which includes Financial Creditors including Financial Institutions, Public sector banks and other lenders.

Q2: The allotment letter to flat buyers have been issued by Jaypee Associates Limited. Should the flat buyer still file claim with Jaypee Infratech Limited?
